A definitive Obturator prosthesis was fabricated after making an accurate impression of the maxillary defect to achieve optimal retention, support and stability. The prosthesis was processed, finished, polished, and inserted with necessary occlusal adjustments, restoring speech, mastication, swallowing, and facial aesthetics.
